Twelve-Month Payment Plan

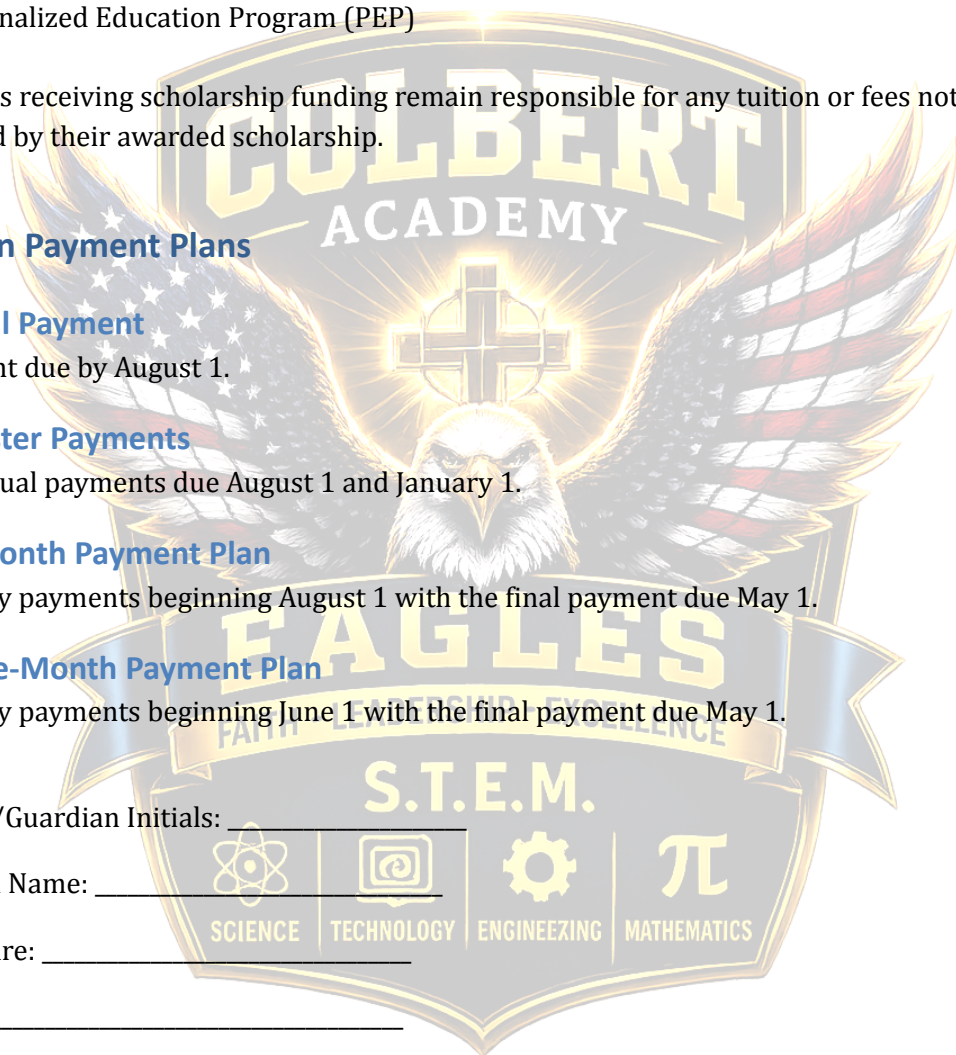
Monthly payments beginning June 1 with the final payment due May 1.

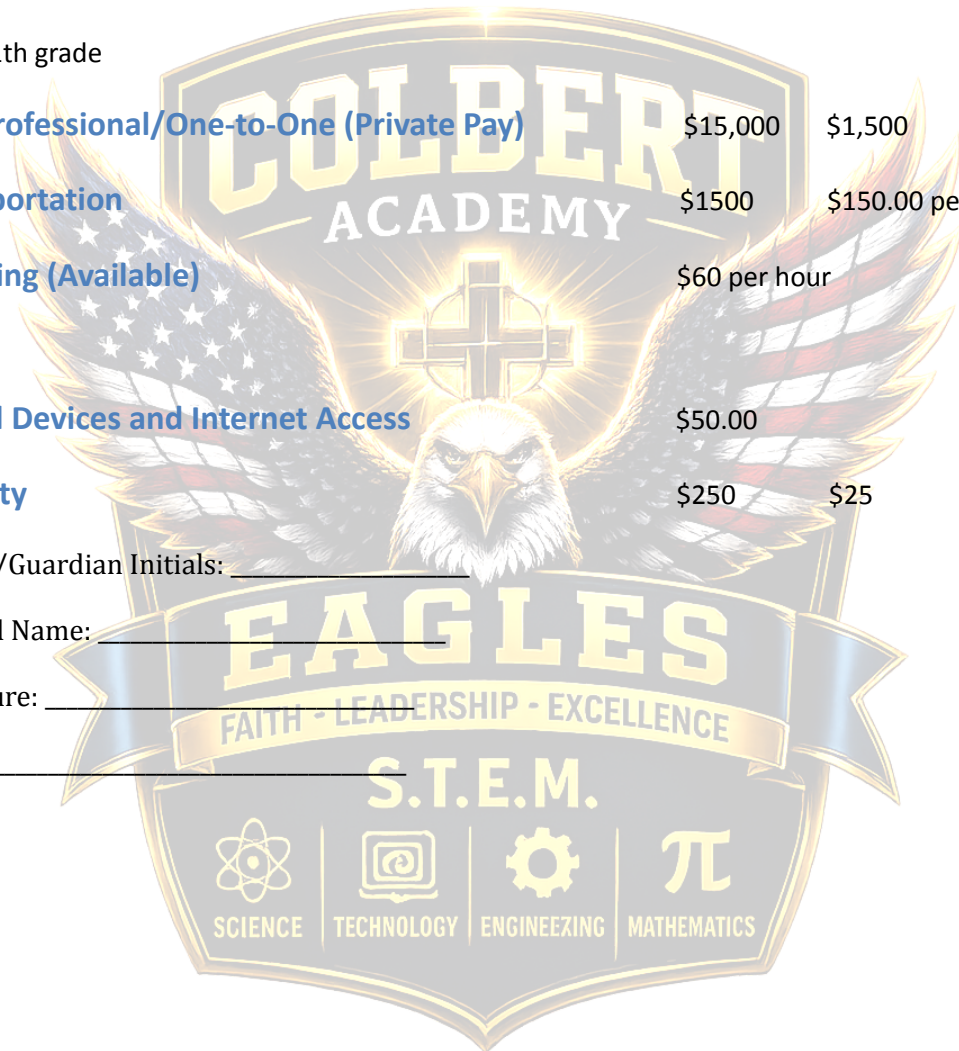
